**Students of High Performance** (SOHP) Students in our SOHP classes are students who have been performing at a higher level in the subjects of Maths, Science, English & Humanities. As part of the SOHP application process, your child will be required to sit the ACER General Achievement Test

> **Concert Band Program** This program has been designed to provide students with the opportunity to further develop their instrumental technique, within the context of a concert band setting. The curriculum is built around ACARA, the Australian Curriculum and focuses on the years 7-10 Music.

Students will be required to audition for a position.

#### **Dance Program of Excellence** (DPOE)

The Dance Program of Excellence has been designed to provide dancers with the opportunity to further develop their dance technique, whilst completing essential Health and Physical Education. The curriculum is built around ACARA. the Australian Curriculum and focuses on the years 7-10 dance band. Students will be required to audition for a place in the program.
